In addition to the sailing races, power boaters have the unique opportunity to play a rousing game of poker on the water in the 'High Card for Hospice' poker rally, with great prizes awarded to those holding the best poker hands at the end of the day. 'High Card' will start and finish at the Northeast Harbor Town Dock, next to Morris Yachts. Land-lubbers can also join the fun by attending the Hospice Regatta Rendezvous at Morris Yachts boat yard in Northeast Harbor on Saturday afternoon, July 13<sup>th</sup>. This social event will feature elegant hors d'oeuvres, specialty drinks, entertainment and an awards ceremony.
